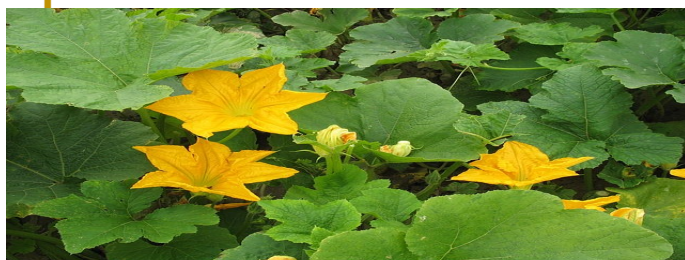

Updated Blackhawk Women Covid Policy effective 9/22/2021

For All Socials and Activities

Contra Costa County has announced a new county wide health order, effective September 22nd, that requires patrons of restaurants and other indoor businesses to show proof they are fully vaccinated or have a negative COVID-19 test result (within 3 days) in order to enter indoor areas.

To abide by this mandate, Blackhawk Women will require members and their guests, to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or show a valid negative COVID-19 test to utilize any indoor facility.

Proof of Vaccination will be accepted in one of the following forms:

- Physical vaccination card
- Proof of vaccination registered with our membership chairwoman, Janinne Franke. Please email a clear photo of your vaccination card as soon as possible to: janinnefranke@yahoo.com. She will keep a database of those vaccinated for all of our events. **Once registered in our database, you will NOT need to show your card at each event.**
- Photo or copy of vaccination card.
- Show a negative COVID-19 test with completed results by a licensed pharmacy or doctor within 3 days.
- Digital vaccination card via CA SMART Health Card

<https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/> to download your digital vaccination card to your phone.

Upon arriving at our events, our host or reservation chair will ask for vaccination verification, if you have **not already provided electronic proof to membership chair**. Masks continue to be mandated by Contra Costa County, regardless of vaccination status. Masks must still be worn to cover the nose and mouth throughout all indoor events, unless actively eating or drinking. Masks are not required at outdoor events. We ask that if you do not have proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test (will be required for each event), you will not be permitted to participate.

We hope you will support our efforts to keep our events safe and understand that these protocols continue to evolve.
